Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at 13850 Cutten Road, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77069, said address being a meeting place of the District.

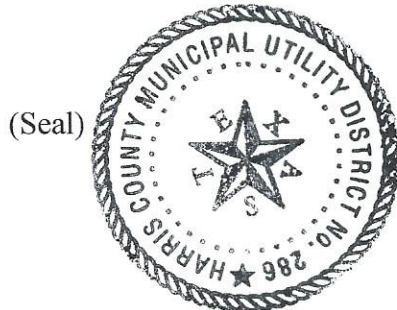
The meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 10, 2024, at 6:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Review and consider approval of the minutes of the December 4, 2023, Board of Directors meeting;
2. Consider the status of contract with the Harris County Sheriff's Office, the status of off-duty Sheriff patrol during December, and the status of security monitoring services, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
3. Consider comments from members of the public;
4. Review and approve audit report for fiscal year ended September 30, 2023, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
5. Status of solid waste collection services by Texas Pride Disposal, including review and approval of request for variable energy charge and Amendment to Residential Solid Waste Collection Contract, and the taking of any actions required in connection therewith;
6. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, and the taking of any action in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and approving the moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
7. Consider adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Personal Property Taxes and authorize delinquent tax attorney to collect delinquent personal property taxes beginning April 1, 2024, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
8. Operator's Report, including:
 - a) Appeals of District charges;
 - b) Refer accounts for collection and approving write-off of uncollectible accounts; and
 - c) Report regarding status of maintenance projects, and the taking of any actions in connection therewith;
 - d) Consider status of cleaning basin and clarifier at WWTP;
 - e) Consider status of FEMA reimbursement;
9. Status of construction contract with TMS for the Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Phase 1 project;
10. Status of construction contract with Canyon Construction for Waterline Lowering Under Faulkey Gully project;

 - b) Status of the North Harris County Regional Water Authority ("Authority");
 - c) Report on operation of flare from Patriot and approval of amended contract in connection with same;
 - d) Report regarding maintenance of park property and trails and consider authorizing repairs relative to same;
 - e) Consider status of Phase 2 cleaning and televising of sanitary sewer lines in the District;
 - f) Consider review of Capital Improvement Plan;
12. Bookkeeper's report, including review of financial and investments reports, and taking of any action required in connection therewith, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
13. Matters for possible placement on future agenda.
